### HOW TO PLAY: GUACAMOLE!

Spread the cards face down. Take turns picking a card. Tell if the card is in the New Testament or Old Testament. If you are correct, keep the card and the next person draws. Keep taking turns. If you draw a Guacamole! card you have to put all of your cards back in the pile. Set a timer and when the timer goes off, the person with the most cards wins.

Variations for the card you draw:

- Name the Bible book before the book on the card
- Name the Bible book after the book on the card
- Name BOTH the book before & after
- Tell what division the book is found in (prophets, law, history, poetry, letters, prophecy, etc.)

Other ways to use your Guacamole books of the Bible cards:

**Sword Drills** - Place the cards in a container. Draw one card out and everyone races to see who can find it in their Bible the fastest or see if you can beat a certain time.

**Nacho Smash** - Lay cards out on the table face up. (You might just use part of the cards). Give each person a flyswatter. (You can have everyone play at once or two people at a time.) Call out a fact about a card (i.e. this book is right before Mark). You can also call out something that would have more than one answer (i.e. one of the Gospels). The first player to hit the correct card gets a point.

**Books in Order** - Mix up the books and see how fast you can put them in order.

### HOW TO PLAY: CHIPS & DIP BOARD GAME

Each player will need a game marker. You can use erasers, pomipoms, legos, or any small item. You will also need a dice.

This game plays similar to the classic Chutes and Ladders game. On your turn, roll the dice and move that many spaces. If you land on a square with a book of the Bible, tell the other players if that book is in the New Testament or Old Testament. If you land on a square at the bottom of a chip trail, climb the chip trail to the square at the top. If you land on a square at the top of a cheese dip slide, slide your marker back down to the bottom of the cheese dip slide. The first player to the end of the board wins.

Variations: Name the Bible book before the book on the square, name the Bible book after the book on the card, or tell what division the book belongs to (prophets, law, history, poetry, letters, prophecy, etc.)
